

Harassment & Illegal Eviction

Harassment and illegal eviction are major problems for many private tenants and their households. Dealing with this kind of complaint requires advisers to have an understanding of the rights of tenants under the Rent (NI) Order 1978 (as amended) and how to enforce them.

Tutored by Housing Rights Service and Environmental Health Officers, this one day course will look at

- Who is protected against harassment and illegal eviction under the Rent (NI) Order 1978 (as amended);
- Distinguishing between tenants and licensees;
- Definitions of harassment and illegal eviction;
- Impact of the Private Tenancies (NI) Order 2006;
- Remedies;
- Role of Environmental Health Officers

This one day course will be of interest to welfare rights/voluntary sector advisers and those working within statutory sector and private sector organisations who may have to advise a private sector tenant regarding their rights. Landlords who wish to obtain a clearer understanding regarding their responsibilities towards their tenants will also wish to attend.
